Up to 60% of all venous thromboembolism (VTE) cases are hospital-associated and VTE is the single leading preventable cause of hospital death.

DID YOU KNOW?

VTE refers collectively to deep vein thrombosis (DVT), a blood clot that occurs in a deep vein usually in the leg, and pulmonary embolism (PE), a clot that breaks loose and travels to the lungs.

STRONG RISK



- Hospitalization
- Surgery
- Extended periods of immobility

MODERATE RISK



- Age (60+)
- Personal or family history of thrombosis
- Cancer/chemotherapy
- Use of estrogen-based medication

OTHER FACTORS



- Obesity
- Pregnancy or recent birth
- Smoking
- Alcohol consumption
